#### Align SB 1383 and the ACF Regulations

- ✓ Ensure that clean transportation and SLCP strategy exist in harmony
- ✓ Ensure that the ACF regulations include the appropriate use of RNG produced from organic waste processing to immediately reduce SLCP emissions
- ✓ Develop markets for RNG produced from the processing of organic waste to help local governments meet SB 1383 procurement requirements

#### Heavy-Duty ZEV Timeline, Performance, and Availability Concerns

✓ Recommend CARB lead in monitoring the ZEV market and verifying the viability of ZEVs for each class of vehicles

#### **Electric Grid and Fueling Infrastructure Reliability**

✓ Work with other State agencies to ensure the electrification infrastructure is ready and publicly accessible charging or fueling infrastructure can accommodate the ZEV fleets transition schedule

#### **Alternative Pathway vs Exemption**

The **Task Force** recommended that CARB:

- Streamline the exemptions process for public fleets and municipal solid waste haul trucks
- Develop a list of provisional exemptions by truck class and regions where ZEVs are not suitable for emergency response

**The Coalition** proposed an Alternative Performance Based Standard to allow private and public solid waste fleets to fuel fleets with currently available in-state, carbon negative RNG
