

Storm Summary 4-25-15 (Preliminary)

This last storm brought sporadic rain to Los Angeles County Saturday afternoon. Rainfall totals were generally between 0.01 and 0.24 inches. The Walnut area accumulated up to 0.40 inches of rain. All stormwater capture facilities captured runoff while on standby. Approximately 25 acre-feet (8.1 million gallons) of storm runoff was captured at the spreading grounds and 41 acre-feet (13.4 million gallons) was captured at the dams. The amount captured in this storm is enough water for 528 people for one year. The figure below shows the rainfall totals from this weather system as of Sunday, April 26, 2015 at 12:00 PM.
