## NOTICE OF UPCOMING PROJECT


Los Angeles County Public Works wants to inform you of an upcoming maintenance project in your Unincorporated County community of Santa Monica Mountains. Weather permitting, the project will tentatively start on January 22, 2024, with work lasting approximately three months.

For the duration of the project, Mulholland Highway at the project location will be closed to all traffic, including vehicular, pedestrian and cyclists. Existing gate closures located at Mile Marker 13.42 & Mile Marker 15.47 will remain in place for the duration of the project.

For your safety and project success, please observe all traffic controls, detour routes, parking restrictions, and flaggers. Also, exercise caution while in the vicinity of all construction activities.
