



## PROPOSED STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT ANNEXATION

PETITION NO. 56-1017

ARROW HIGHWAY

Dear Property Owner:

On May 9, 2023, Public Works hosted a 2nd community meeting to present and discuss the status of a request for street lighting in your neighborhood, as well as the selected streetlight design and their proposed locations and associated costs. A sketch showing the affected properties and type and locations of the proposed streetlights is attached.

The next steps of the annexation process will be to present the proposed annexation to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles for approval. In Fall 2023 (tentative), a Streetlight Assessment ballot and a Notice of Public Hearing will be mailed to you, as well as other affected property owners, so you can formally vote in support of or in opposition to the proposed levy of assessments against the affected properties to pay for the operation and maintenance cost of streetlights. The ballot results will determine if streetlights will be installed.
